

On the order of compiling general voter lists for the preparation of conducting the election of People's Deputies of Ukraine
March 26th, 2006

With the aim of preparing for the conduct of the election of People's Deputies of Ukraine on March 26th 2006, according to articles 39 and 40 of the Law of Ukraine "On the Election of People's Deputies of Ukraine" (amended July 7th 2005), following clauses 1 and 10 of articles 12 and 13, and article 19 of the Law of Ukraine "On the Central Election Commission," the Central Election Commission

Resolves:

- To approve the order of compiling the general voter lists for the preparation of conducting the election of People's Deputies of Ukraine on March 26th, 2006 (attached)
- To send this resolution to the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Ukraine, Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Ukraine, Ministry of Defence, Ministry of Education and Science, Ministry of Labor and Social Politics of Ukraine, Ministry of Justice of Ukraine, State Department of Ukraine for Execution of Punishment of Ukraine, Verkhovna Rada of the Autonomous Republic of Crimea, Kyiv and Sevastopol city and oblast councils, Councils of the Ministries of the Autonomous Republic of Crimea, oblast, Kyiv and Sevastopol city state administrations, and also working groups on voter registry after their creation.
- Heads of regional working groups on voter registry, the head of the working group on the registration of voters who live or currently reside abroad, must send information to the Central Election Commission regarding the staff, locations, telephone numbers and email addresses of the respective rayon, city (cities of republic importance in the Autonomous Republic of Crimea, oblast importance), regional working groups on voter registry, the working group on the registration of voters who live or currently reside abroad, until and including September 9th 2005.

The order of compiling the general voter lists for the preparation of conducting the elections of People's Deputies of Ukraine on March 26th 2006 must be published in the 'Holos Ukrainy' and 'Uriadovyj kurer' newspapers.
